- Practise times tables (2s, 5s and 10s)—chant them, write them as a list, make them from objects (Y2 use TT Rockstars)
 - Follow a recipe and measure the ingredients carefully using scales and measuring jugs.
 - Numbots-your login details should be working again!
 - Go on a shape hunt around your house/garden.
 - Create your own shape monster using 2D or 3D shapes.
 - Practise telling the time on an analogue clock whenever you can-when is tea time? How long is it until bed time? Etc.
 - Create tally charts/pictograms for items in your house.
 - Create a Maths quiz for someone else-mark it!
- Our Science topic is Plants:**
- Look at the different plants in your garden/surrounding area. Can you identify them?
 - Draw/paint/collage pictures of different plants and trees that you can see.
